MEASURING AND HEIGHT CARD INFORMATION

Effective January 1, 2010, exhibitors are no longer required to provide proof to Trial Secretaries that their dog has a valid jump height card as part of the check-in process. Furthermore, this change eliminates the need for a copy of the Jump Height Card to be submitted with an entry form. Dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form may still compete; but they must be measured/wicketed by the Judge of Record PRIOR to running in their class, and this measurement will be valid for that weekend of trials only. The exception to this requirement is a dog entered in the 24" or 26" height division. However, if a Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO) or an Agility Field Rep is present - ALL dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form must be measured at some time during the trial or cluster of trials. This does not preclude having the dog wicketed by the Judge of Record if the VMO or Rep is not available to measure the dog before its first run of the trial or cluster of trials. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores.

SIMPLIFIED JUMP HEIGHT CARD PROCESS

When filling out the entry form, there is a new section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether your dog needs to be officially measured. Please check the box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the Dogs To Be Measured List. It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate. Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations it includes both sexes.

Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. Puppies under four (4) months of age are strictly prohibited from the trial grounds.

All entries, including wait-listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to 6:00 pm Friday April 16th, 2021. All entries that are withdrawn by 6:00 pm, Mon, April 19th, 2021 will be replaced by a wait-listed entry, if available. OBSTACLES AND RING CONDITIONS

Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility Trials. All contact obstacles have rubberized surfaces. All classes will take place indoors in an arena with a packed dirt surface. The ring size will be 100' x 100' minimum. Electronic Timing will be used all three days.

COURSE WALK-THROUGHS AND WARM-UP INFORMATION

[Subject to change due to Covid-19 Restrictions. Please see the attached COVID-19 Instructions for additional trial information.]

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, during a walk-through period held prior to the start of the class. The walk-through is restricted to handlers entered in that class only. Handlers with multiple dogs, at events with multiple rings may request to walk with a height group other than the one their dog is entered in if a conflict is imminent.

A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, may be provided for exhibitors. The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the dog and not for training or relieving of the dog.

All exhibitors should obtain a copy of the Regulations for Agility Trials by downloading them from the American Kennel Club website at http://www.akc.org/rules/.

RIBBONS, AWARDS, AND PRIZES

Ribbons will be awarded in each jump height division in each class as follows: First Place.......Blue Second Place......Red Third Place......Yellow Fourth Place......White Qualifying Score......Dark Green

A New Title rosette will be awarded to all dog and handler teams finishing a title. A MACH/PACH/PAX rosette and bar will be awarded to all dog and handler teams that attain their MACH/PACH/PAX.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS & SITE INFORMATION

SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY:

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The DMGRC and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. The DMGRC reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the DMGRC or any official thereof. All dogs must be on leash at all times when on trial grounds except when in the designated warm-up area or competing on the course.

REFUNDS:

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee.

Bitches in season are not permitted at the Trial. Entry fees minus a \$5.00 processing fee per trial day WILL be refunded for bitches coming in season after the closing date. Owner must present certificate from veterinarian no later than one half hour prior to start of the first class of the day of the trial.

No refund checks (for any reason) will be written for amounts under \$5.00.

RINGSIDE:

Dogs may arrive any time prior to judging if the dog has a valid temporary or permanent jump height card. Otherwise, they must be available for measuring prior to the start of their class if a VMO or AKC Field Rep is available to measure dogs. All dogs not needed for further judging will be excused.

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

ADDITIONAL SITE INFORMATION:

Crating spaces are available on a limited basis. Crates may be left overnight; however, the DMGRC and the Jester Park Equestrian Center will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the show site.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Trial Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations around the show grounds.

Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend – Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day

Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed. Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend. Entry fees will still be assessed as one day of entries for one dog - \$24 for first entry, \$14 for additional entries regardless of class/jump height.

I have provided two entry forms on the premium for those that would like to take advantage of the preferred/regular entry option. PLEASE read confirmation emails to verify your entry is correct!!!

Fix and Go On (FNG)

As of January 1, 2020, Fix and Go On will be offered on a one-year pilot basis in order to give AKC time to evaluate its impact. FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score. Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run.

Entering For Exhibition Only (FEO)

FEO IS BEING OFFERED AT THIS TRIAL ALL THREE DAYS

As of January 1, 2020, For Exhibition Only may be offered at the option of the host club. FEO will be offered on a one-year pilot basis in order to give AKC time to evaluate its impact. FEO will allow exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is only allowed in the Time 2 Beat and FAST classes. FEO will be of value to new exhibitors or exhibitors that are having difficulty with a specific obstacle and/or ring environment. Competitors must enter in T2B and/or FAST. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.

• FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) (T2B and/or FAST) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.

• Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.

• Dogs may be entered in any level of FAST (Novice, Open, Excellent, Master). If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.

• The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out. FEO may be declared earlier (ex. when checking in at the gate board).

• A judge must monitor the entire run. Judges can stop a run at any time.

- \circ Toys are allowed in the ring
- Toys must be non-audible
- Toys may not leave the handler's hand
- Toys that roll freely cannot be used
- Food/treats are not allowed in the ring
- FEO should be utilized for the benefit of the dog and not as a punitive correction. Harsh verbal and /or physical corrections shall not be tolerated. Any determination of harshness by the judge shall be immediately whistled and the handler will be dismissed from the ring.

The Des Moines Golden Retriever Club (DMGRC) is working to make our upcoming AKC agility trial as safe of an environment for dogs and exhibitors as possible, so we have added the guidelines below to help with spacing and social distancing during the trial. We hope to see many friends and enjoy time with our dogs on April 23-25, 2021 at the Jester Park Equestrian Center

COVID-19 GUIDELINES

The Des Moines Golden Retriever Club has instituted the following practices for all handers, ring crew, volunteers, attendees, and spectators to reduce exposure to COVID-19. DMGRC believes that all attending will make good decisions with regard to their health and the health of others to prevent the spread of COVID-19. Social distancing, hand washing and good hygiene, and the wearing of protective equipment are all part of the CDC recommendations and the lowa Department of Health at this time.

There may be revisions on the trial date.

1. Masks will be required for all individuals while inside the building, except during the actual running of the course in the ring. Masks must be worn while waiting to enter the ring and must be immediately put back on following completion of the course. Any person not properly wearing a mask may be asked to leave the trial site by a club member.

- 2. Please bring your own pens or pencils and hand sanitizer or wipes. There will be some on hand, but your own will be best for comfort and recognizability.
- 3. Ring crew, scribe, sheet, gate & timer volunteers will have gloves available to use if desired and hand sanitizer will be available for ring and gate volunteers.

4. Walk Thrus: Walk thrus will be limited to a maximum of 25 handlers and masks are required. There will not be a countdown for classes with multiple walk thrus. All walk thrus will be completed before any runs. For example, if there are three walkthroughs, it will be walk, walk, run with no "five minutes before first dog" timeframe.

5. Briefings: There will be NO briefings for Exc/Master for any class or for Premier classes. There will be (socially distanced) briefings for all Novice/Open and for FAST & T2B classes.

- **6. Leash Runner**: There will be a leash runner. There will also be disinfectant spray and paper towels to periodically clean the ring gates.
- **7. Food**: Concessions will be determined at a date closer to the trial depending on current CDC recommendations. That information will be included with the exhibitor letter.

8. Check In: The Gate Steward will check you in for your class as you enter for your walk thru. Conflicts should be minimal as there is only one ring being utilized. However, if you do have a conflict, please let the Gate Steward know and they will make the change. It is suggested to take a picture of the gate sheet so you may plan accordingly.

9. Measurement: Unless a VMO is present, there will be no dogs measured at the trial and handlers are on their "honor" as to what height they run their dogs.

10. Crating: This trial is now a true one-ring trial. There will not be a separate "Standard" ring or "Jumpers" ring. Instead, the north half of the building where the "Standard" ring was traditionally held will be available for crating. Crating will NOT be allowed along the eastern side of the ring where the bleachers are located. This area will now be designated

as a viewing area for chairs only, which shall be spaced out to allow for proper social distancing. There will be signs posted along the walkways around the ring as they will be one-way only. As always, dogs may be crated in your car, but please be mindful about the weather. The safety of your dog is paramount. There is building layout map included on my website (referenced below).

11. Course Maps: Course maps will be posted by class each evening by 7pm at https://caitowenstrialsec.wixsite.com/mysite . Course maps will also be posted at the trial site, but no printed copies will be available. It is suggested to either print copies at home, download them to your phone, or take a picture of them at the trial site.

12. Ribbons: Ribbons will not be self-serve. A volunteer will be available at the ribbon station and will provide you with your ribbons upon request.

13. Restrooms will be available for use and will be regularly cleaned by Jester Park staff throughout the day. Jester Park Equestrian Center is a facility owned and run by Polk County Conservation and follows all local and state health guidelines.

14. The judge will be using an electronic whistle instead of a blown whistle.

15. Last, but certainly not least, if you are feeling ill, STAY HOME.

Any person who fails to follow the site distance plan or instructions and maintain at least six feet between individuals at all times during this event or on the show grounds during show hours will be investigated by the trial committee for misconduct prejudicial to the interests of the sport and may result in expulsion from this event and possible sanction by AKC.

AGILITY TRIAL MOVE-UP FORM

USE THIS FORM TO MOVE UP TO A HIGHER AGILITY CLASS ONLY

It is the option of the club to allow day-to-day move-ups. Exhibitors should refer to a club's premium list to verify the club's policy for moving a dog up. If offered, dogs shall be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner, as a result of the dog qualifying for an agility title. The request for moving up must be made to the Trial Secretary according to the club's published policy. All move-up entries are subject to availability of the class and payment of any difference in entry fee. Dogs so moved-up will be entered at the end of the running order. Refer to Chapter 1, Section 20 of the Regulations for Agility Trials for additional move-up requirements.
