During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries designated as either online entries or paper entries will be as follows: Online Entries: 110 runs online (33%) 220 Paper entries: (67%). If either form of entry has not filled at the end of the 48 hour time period, the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either the online or paper limits accordingly.

LIMITED TRIAL ENTRIES

Entries received within 24 hours of the opening date and time must include postage or be metered; be delivered by a multi-state or multi-national postal or carrier service, including but not limited to USPS, FedEx, UPS, and DHL. (Effectively disallows conventional "hand deliveries" during the first 24 hours the trial is open). No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

No entries will be accepted by phone, fax or hand delivery.

WAIT LIST for Withdrawn Entries after the Closing Date/Time

DMGRC is offering a Wait List to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial's closing date/time. A maximum of 30 entries will be placed on the club's wait list. All entries, including wait list entries must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to the 6:00 pm, Friday, September 4, 2015. DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate.

Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations it includes both sexes.

Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind or deaf shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. Puppies under six months of age are strictly prohibited from the trial grounds.

HEIGHT DIVISIONS

MEASURING and HEIGHT CARD INFORMATION

Effective January 1, 2010, exhibitors are no longer required to provide proof to Trial Secretaries that their dog has a valid jump height card as part of the check-in process. Furthermore, this change eliminates the need for a copy of the jump height card to be submitted with an entry form. Dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form may still compete; but they must be measured/wicketed by the **Judge of Record** PRIOR to running in their class and this measurement will be valid for that weekend of trials only. The exception to this requirement is a dog entered in the 24" or 26" height division. However, if a **Volunteer Measuring Official** (VMO) or an **Agility Field Rep** is present; **ALL** dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form

must be measured at some time during the trial or cluster of trials. This does not preclude having the dog wicketed by the Judge of Record if the VMO or Rep is not available to measure the dog **before** its first run of the trial or cluster of trials. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores.

NEW Simplified Jump Height Card Process

When filling out the entry form, there is a new section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether your dog needs to be officially measured. Please check the appropriate box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the *Dogs To Be Measured List*. It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in.

OBSTACLES AND RING CONDITIONS

Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility Trials. All classes will take place indoors on a Packed Dirt surface. Ring size will be 90 x 90 Std Ring, 100 x 80 Jumpers Ring.

COURSE WALK-THROUGHS AND WARM-UP INFORMATION

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, during a walk-through period held prior to the start of the class. The walk-through is restricted to handlers entered in that class only. Handlers with multiple dogs, at events with multiple rings may request to walk with a height group other than the one their dog is entered in if a conflict is imminent.

A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, may be provided for exhibitors. The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the dog and not for training or relieving of the dog.

RIBBONS, AWARDS, AND PRIZES

Ribbons will be awarded in each jump height division in each class as follows:

First Place.....Blue Second Place.....Red Third Place....Yellow Fourth Place.....White Qualifying Score...Dark Green

A New Title rosette will be awarded to all dog and handler teams finishing a title. A MACH/PACH/PAX rosette and MACH/PACH/PAX bar will be awarded to all dog and handler teams that attain their MACH/PACH.

In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The Des Moines Golden Retriever Club and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. The Des Moines Golden Retriever Club reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the Des Moines Golden Retriever.

All dogs must be on leash at all times when on trial grounds except when in the designated warm-up area or competing on the course.

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee.

Excellent Class Name Change

Beginning January 1, 2013, to help the confusion that had been occurred over the years with Excellent A and Excellent B classes, which are two distinctly different classes, the AKC is renaming them to match the names of the titles that are earned from those two different classes. The name of the Excellent A class will change to "Excellent" and the name of the Excellent B class will change to "Master". Please note, only the name is changing. The class themselves and the title earned remain the same.

Bitches in season are not permitted to compete in Agility Trials. Entry Fees less \$10 administrative fee and applicable AKC recording fees per day will be refunded for bitches coming in season after the closing date. Owner must present certificate from veterinarian prior to start of show.

Dogs may arrive any time prior to judging if the dog has a valid temporary or permanent jump height card. Otherwise, they must be available for measuring prior to the start of their class if a VMO or AKC Field Rep is available to measure dogs. All dogs not needed for further judging will be excused. **Judges are not required** to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

This club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC Entry Form for this event.

ADDITIONAL SITE INFORMATION

Crating space will be available on a limited basis. Crates may be left overnight; however, the Des Moines Golden Retriever Club and the Jester Park Equestrian Center will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the show site.

A full service food concession is available on the site.

No overnight parking will be allowed at the trial site. No electrical hook-ups for motor homes or campers are available. Camping is available at nearby Jester Park

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an **Agility Jump Height Card** may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.
