In an emergency situation an exhibitor has the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund.

English Springer Spaniels & Welsh Springer Spaniels may be judged on the ground or on a ramp.

A Recording Fee of 50 cents for each dog and an AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 will be required for each recordable single entry class at any Licensed or Member Club Show or Obedience Trial. 

 - *For Golden Retrievers & Shetland Sheepdogs Eight (8) years or older.
 - *For Great Danes & Pomeranians Six (6) years or older.

HUNTING DOG CLASS - A Class for Dogs that have achieved the AKC Junior Hunter, Senior Hunter or Master Hunter Titles (Qualifying Score or Title from Hunting Test).

HUNTING BITCH CLASS - A Class for Bitches that have achieved the AKC Junior Hunter, Senior Hunter or Master Hunter Titles (Qualifying Score or Title from Hunting Test).

HUNTING DOG CLASS - (Welsh Springer Spaniels) A Class for Dogs that have achieved the WD, WDX or at least one qualification for the AKC Junior Hunter, Senior Hunter or Master Hunter Title.

HUNTING BITCH CLASS - (Welsh Springer Spaniels) A Class for Bitches that have achieved the WD, WDX or at least one qualification for the AKC Junior Hunter, Senior Hunter or Master Hunter Title.

SHOOTING DOG CLASS - Open to any English Springer Spaniel Dog that has earned the Parent Club Working Certificate, Working Certificate Excellent, or has at least one leg toward any AKC Hunting Title. Judging will be on conformation only.

SHOOTING BITCH CLASS - Open to any English Springer Spaniel Bitch that has earned the Parent Club Working Certificate, Working Certificate Excellent, or has at least one leg toward any AKC Hunting Title. Judging will be on conformation only.

DUAL CHAMPIONSHIP DOG CLASS - For any dog that has been awarded the title of Champion of Record & the title of Field Champion.

DUAL CHAMPIONSHIP BITCH CLASS - For any dog that has been awarded the title of Champion of Record & the title of Field Champion.

NON-REGULAR (ADDITIONAL) CLASSES Involving Multiple Dog Entries

As the judge's decision in the Non-Regular Classes involving Multiple Dog Entries is based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes.

STUD DOG CLASS - For Stud Dogs and two of their Get. It is not necessary that the Get be under the same ownership as that of the Stud Dog. The Stud Dog may be entered separately in one of the regular classes, or if a Champion of Record in Best of Breed Competition, but MUST be entered in the Stud Dog Class, the Get MUST be entered in one of the regular classes. The Stud Dog shall be considered as one entry and requires one entry fee, this being the regular fee plus the additional class fee if the Stud Dog is entered in another class. The Stud Dog must be shown in the ring with the Get. The class will be judged on the merits of the Get.

BROOD BITCH CLASS - Same as for the Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

**BRACE CLASS - Two dogs of the same Breed or Variety of Breed with one or more common owner and both dogs must be entered in another class.

**For Pomeranians Only - Dogs need not be entered in another class.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION

NOVICE JUNIOR CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 9 and under 12 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOVICE INTERMEDIATE CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 12 and under 15 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOVICE SENIOR CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 15 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN JUNIOR CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 9 and under 12 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present in the Novice Class.

OPEN INTERMEDIATE CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 12 and under 15 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present in the Novice Class.

OPEN SENIOR CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 15 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present in the Novice Class.

MASTER CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 9 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show and who have won ten (10) Best Junior Handler awards with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed, all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.


